

*Sale & Consumption of Spirituous & Vinous Liquors
on Sunday*

OFFICIAL RETURN OF VOTES

At a Special Town Meeting of the inhabitants of the Town of Phillips, in the County of Franklin, qualified to vote, duly called and legally held on Tuesday, November 5, 1985, the said inhabitants cast their ballots for the following Local Option Questions referred to the people in accordance with MRSA Title 28, 1964, Section 101. These ballots were received, sorted, counted, and declared in open meeting in accordance with Title 21-A, MRSA, Section 695 by the Moderator and the Clerk made a record thereof, as follows:

The total number of Local Option Ballots cast was 220.

On Article 2 of the warrant of the Special Town Meeting on November 5, 1985 was Question No.2 - "Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for the sale herein of spirituous and vinous liquor to be consumed on the premises of establishments qualified to sell spirituous and vinous liquor for consumption on the premises?"

120 Yes Votes
100 No Votes

On Article 3 of the warrant of the Special Town Meeting on November 5, 1985 was Question No.3 - "Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for the sale herein of malt liquor (beer, ale and other malt liquor) to be consumed on the premises of establishments qualified to sell malt liquor for consumption on premises?"

122 Yes Votes
97 No Votes

On Article 4 of the warrant of the Special Town Meeting on November 5, 1985 was Question No.6 - "Shall this municipality or unincorporated place authorize the sale of spirituous and vinous liquor on Sunday for consumption on the premises of establishments licensed to sell spirituous liquor for consumption on the premises?"

94 Yes Votes
124 No Votes

On Article 5 of the warrant of the Special Town Meeting on November 5, 1985 was Question No.7 - "Shall this municipality or unincorporated place authorize the sale on Sunday of malt liquor (beer, ale or other malt liquor) to be consumed on the premises of establishments licensed to sell malt liquor for consumption on the premises?"

101 Yes Votes
118 No Votes
