

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS IN  
THE TOWN OF PHILLIPS

1. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for public safety, to protect property located at all parks and recreation areas, and to promote equitable use of park facilities.
2. No person shall enter Toothaker Park, also known as North Franklin Park, at any time after 9:00 P.M. or before 6:00 A.M. without authorization of the Conservation Commission. The Conservation Commission is the group authorized by the Selectmen to administer the parks and promote recreational activities. Violators of these rules shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$ 100.00 and costs or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, and /or an equivalent in Community Service work.
3. The removal of, alteration of or damage to anything natural, physical or historical within the areas is strictly prohibited.
4. Refuse must be placed in containers provided, except that perishable refuse must not be left in the parks. Groups are responsible for cleaning up after their gatherings.
5. Open fires are prohibited.
6. Ball playing and similar activities will be confined to areas designated for that purpose.
7. Arrangements for groups must be made in advance with the Conservation Commission or their agents.

## SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

The inhabitants of the Town of Phillips, qualified to vote in said town affairs, assembled at the Phillips Middle School in said town, on Saturday, the seventh day of June AD 2003, at one o'clock in the afternoon, to act on the following articles to wit:

Article 1: It was voted, by written ballot, to have Michael Ellis preside as Moderator at said meeting.

Article 2: It was voted by written ballot to have Jane Thorndike as School Board Director to School Administrative District No.58 for a three year term.

Article 3: It was voted, by hand, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$ 7,795.00 for ambulance service for Option 2 as discussed at the Public Informational Meeting on June 5<sup>th</sup>. And authorize the Selectmen, on behalf of the Town, to enter into a one year contract with Franklin Memorial Hospital from August 1, 2003 to July 31, 2004.

Article 4: It was voted by hand, to raise and appropriate the recommended amount of \$600.00 for Constables for the ensuing year.

Article 5: It was voted, by hand, for the Town to appropriate the sum of \$1,300.00 to replace the tank on the Forestry truck from the Fire Department Equipment Reserve Fund as recommended.

Article 6: It was voted by hand for the Town to approve a Community Development Program and Community Block Grant for Public Infrastructure Fund Application in the amount of up to \$ 400,000.00, and to authorize the Municipal Officers to accept said grant funds to make assurances, assume such responsibilities and exercise such authority as necessary and reasonable to implement such program.

Article 7: The Town voted, by hand, to accept the following amendment to the Town of Phillips Ordinance regulating the use of parks and recreational areas in the Town of Phillips; as recommended.

Amendment to Section 2 to read:

2. No person shall enter any municipal park in the Town of Phillips at any time after 9:00 P. M. or before 6:00 A. M. without authorization of the Conservation Commission. The Conservation Commission is the group authorized by the Selectmen to administer the parks and promote recreational activities. Violators of these rules shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 and costs or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days and/or an equivalent in Community Service work.
