

# Phillips Floodplain Study

The Town of Phillips and The Nature Conservancy in Maine (TNC) are partnering on a pilot project to explore how rural communities can reduce the risk and impacts of river flooding in ways that are in harmony with nature. A team will be working with the Town to understand:

- What are the community's biggest concerns about flooding?
- Where are the worst flooding spots in Phillips?
- What solutions are possible that protect people, wildlife, and habitat?
- Which locations would be good candidates for potential projects to reduce flood risk?
- How could such projects be financed?
