TO: Emma Jane Andrews, a resident of the Town of Phillips in the County of Franklin and State of Maine.

**GREETING:** In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Phillips, qualified to vote in said Town affairs, to assemble at the **Phillips Area Community Center**, 21 Depot Street in said Town, on **Saturday, August 8, 2026 at 9:00 o'clock in the morning**, to act on the following articles, to wit:

**Article 1:** To elect a Moderator to preside at said meeting. Written ballot needed.

**Please stand for the Pledge of Allegiance**

**Article 2:** To see if the Town will authorize the Select Board to purchase a 2027 Western Star plow truck, requiring no down payment, with an annual payment of \$42,964.02 for a term of 5 years at an interest rate of 5.72%. Delivery date of the 2027 Western Star is anticipated to be late September of 2026.

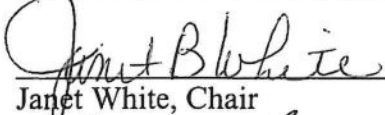
*This estimated amount takes into consideration the funds previously raised for the admin clerks' positions of which one is now vacant.*

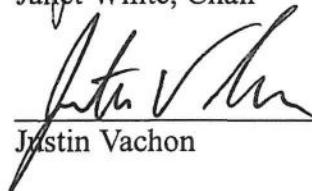
**Article 4:**

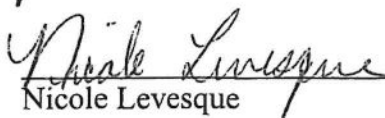
